



2020 OKC Futurity Contestant FAQ's

Stalls & Bedding

- Stall assignments are online at OKCFuturity.com.
- The stalls are open for move-in on Tuesday at 12:01am. That means any time AFTER midnight Monday night. Absolutely not horses allowed on the grounds Monday before midnight!
- The Feed & Bedding office is located on the fairgrounds behind the Barn 6 Performance Arena. You can call to get stalls pre-bedded at (405) 948-6786. The bedding office will not be open overnight so make sure to get stalls pre-bedded if you plan to arrive before 8am Tuesday.
- Stall mats are available for rent from Elite Stall Mat Rentals at (855) 628-7200 or online at stallmatrentals.com.

- The VIP RV lot on the north end of barn row is sold out. There are approximately 70 paved spaces in the south premium lot and more than 300 in the regular RV park available from the fairgrounds on a first come, first serve basis. These spaces cannot be reserved.

Check-in

- Check-in will open from 8am to 6pm on Tuesday and from 8am to 12pm on Wednesday on the east end of the arena in Barn 3.
- You will need your original horse papers, a negative coggins and health papers (if out of state).
- You will receive a hip number to be worn on the left side of your saddle pad any time you enter the arena. We will not be numbering horses, so they need not be brought to check-in.
- You must check-in before taking your exhibition.

Exhibitions

- You must wear your hip number in order to exhibition.
- FRG Futurity and AIP Rookie Futurity Exhibitions will begin at 10am on Tuesday. Exhibitions will be run in draw order. We will go through the FRG Futurity draw, then repeat to pick up any missed during the first pass. We will then do the same for the AIP Rookie Futurity. Any horse missing their exhibition call on both passes will forfeit their exhibition.
- Exhibitions are limited to one (1) minute. There will be a \$100 fine for exceeding this time limit.
- Slot horse exhibition will begin at 8am on Wednesday and will be run in draw order. We will only make one pass through the draw, so don't miss your turn!

Membership and Horse Nominations

- All contestants must be current BBR members at the time of the event.
- Additionally, those competing in the AIP Rookie Futurity must hold a BBR Futurity Riders Guild membership and Rookie Futurity horses must be nominated to the Futurity Riders Guild.
- We have sent emails to anyone missing the required memberships and/or nominations listed above. Please try to take care of these memberships prior to the event in order to minimize traffic in the show office.

COVID Protocols

The State of Oklahoma and Oklahoma County in particular has experienced a significant increase in the number of cases and hospitalizations in the past few months. As a result, we are being required to implement the following protocols to help prevent the country from becoming a "hot spot." We want everyone to know that our ability to ensure compliance with these protocols will directly affect our ability to complete this event or to have future events at the OKC Fairgrounds facilities!

- Masks are required at all times in the coliseum seating area, vendor areas, check-in area, show office or any other location when you are unable to maintain separation from those not from your household. Masks will be provided to all contestants at check-in.
- Contestants, vendors and attendees, whether in barns, vendor areas or seating areas, shall not congregate in groups large than 10 people and must follow social distancing guidelines.
- A complete set of COVID-10 protocols will be posted at check-in and throughout the facility.
- Failure to abide by these protocols may result in removal from the grounds and disqualification.

Draw & Stall Assignments

- In order to minimize crowding, all draws, stall assignments and results will be posted online only. Please visit OKCFuturity.com to find these items. (Note: Scanning the QR code with your phone will take you to the correct page!)
- Futurity, Rookie Futurity and Derby draws are complete and are currently available.
- Slot Race contestants are listed online, and the draw will be posted as soon as it is available. The draw for the Slot Race will take place at 2pm Tuesday afternoon in Barn 3. A representative of each slot holder should be present to draw their number. All those riding two horses will draw first and will draw both horses in order of their first horse's name. If there is not at least 10 between their draw they will redraw for the second horse. Remaining contestants will draw in alphabetical order of their horse's name as listed in the program.
- Sweepstakes, Youth and American draw will be posted as soon as possible after the books close at 5pm on Monday.
- Junior American sidepot entries will be posted as soon as possible after the books close at 5pm on Thursday. Note: Anyone entering the Junior American MUST be entered in the Youth race!
